Course Description

An exposition of Acts 13-28. Introduces Paul from the gospel records and focuses on the apostle's leadership in the early church. Emphasizes the historical background, contextual interpretation, and contemporary application of the text.

Course Readings

- 1. Read Acts 13-28, 3 times in 3 different translations.
- 2. Read selected readings from James Boice, Acts (ISBN 9780801066337).

Learning Objectives

- 1. The student will learn the life of Paul from the Gospels.
- 2. The student will master the chapter content of Acts 13-28.
- 3. The student will explain points of interpretation in Acts.
- 4. The student will explain the message of Acts using structural and theological elements.

Test

One final exam (essay, short answer, and chapter content)

- 1. Write an essay on a topic given in class.
- 2. Give short answers with explanations (\sim 3-5 sentences) for interpretation questions.
- 3. Give short answers on chapter content of Acts.
- 4. Did you read Acts 3 times in 3 translations and complete the Boice readings on time?

Reading in Boice

- Chapters 26-29, 31-32, 35-38, 41, 43-46, 48-50 of Boice are required reading.
- Take notes (highly recommended) on readings to determine the meaning of passages (see under *Test* #2 above).
- Boice and Bible readings due by Nov. 14, 2014. 5% late penalty for each day late.
