## Block Class: Th312 Early Church History October 5–10, 2015

### Description

Focuses on church history from the close of the New Testament to the time of Augustine of Hippo. Traces the development of the church and church doctrine. Emphasizes church councils and significant influential early church leaders.

**Brian Collins** (PhD, Bob Jones University) serves as an elder at Mount Calvary Baptist Church and as a Bible Integration Specialist at BJU Press. His dissertation, *Scripture, Hermeneutics, and Theology: Evaluating Theological Interpretation of Scripture* investigated the topics of scripture and tradition, hermeneutics, and the relation between biblical theology and systematic theology as they were understood from the patristic era to the present.
