Course Description

An exposition of the book of Revelation focusing on competing views, theology, and interpretation for preaching and teaching.

Course Reading(s)

- 1. Read the book of Revelation 4 times in 4 different translations.
- 2. Read selected readings from John Walvoord, *The Revelation of Jesus Christ* (either ISBN 9780802473127 or 9780802473097).

Learning Objectives

- 1. The student will learn the various systems of interpretation and reasons for a literal interpretation.
- 2. The student will master the chapter content of Revelation.
- 3. The student will explain difficulties of interpretation in Revelation.
- 4. The student will explain the message of Revelation using structural and theological elements.

Test

One final exam (essay, short answer, and chapter content)

- 1. Write an essay on the message of Revelation and its usefulness.
- 2. Give short answers with explanations (\sim 3-5 sentences) concerning difficult interpretations.
- 3. Give short answers on chapter content of Revelation.
- 4. Did you read Revelation 4 times in 4 translations and complete the Walvoord readings on time?

Reading in Walvoord

- Chapters 4-22 of Walvoord are required reading.
- Take notes (highly recommended) on readings to determine the meaning of difficult passages (see under *Test* #2 above). Questions given in class.
- Walvoord and Bible readings due by August 27, 2016. 5% late penalty for each day late.
